**MACKENIZE PARK/CHURCH STREET STORMWATER REHABILITATION CDBG PROJECT**

Mr. Pignoli called on Khal Hassan, the Borough Engineer, to summarize the bids. Nine bids were received. The total bids ranged from \$80,880 to \$286,610. The Engineer's Opinion of Probable Costs valued the project between \$ 120,000 to \$ 140,000. The low bidder was Richard Fox Contractors Inc. for a total bid of \$ 80,880. Mr. Hassan and the Borough have worked with Richard Fox Contractors Inc. in the past and found their work to be satisfactory. The County reviewed the bids and found them in order. Mr. Hassan recommended the bid be awarded to Richard Fox Contractors Inc. for the base bid with the three alternates.

Mr. Costello questioned the signature of Khal Hassan on the bid tabulation sheet. Mr. Hassan said that is standard operating procedure. Mr. Pignoli asked if there were additional questions. There were none. Mr. Pignoli called for a motion to award the MacKenzie Park/Church Street Stormwater Rehabilitation Project with a bid of \$ 67,140 for the base bid; \$ 8,450 for add alternate 1; \$ 3,400 for add alternate 2; \$1,890 for add alternate 3 for a total low bid of \$ 80,880.

The motion passed 4 to 0.

Mr. Couris asked when the project will begin. Mr. Hassan said very soon. Under the grant the project must be completed by the end of August.

Mr. Walker suggested we move forward on the Ford Street project being the pricing is very attractive.
